- Moved to the butchery categories for the remaining 6 months, sourced an alternative supplier for all beef prime cuts which reduced cost by 30% whilst providing better supplier levels bringing availability above 90% per week.
- Planned exit strategies for old stock or when overstocked to reduce profit loss within the categories to less than 3%.

Inventory Planner Produce & Butchery

- Reduced stock holding of potatoes, apples. oranges by 50% while maintaining stock availability via a change in ordering parameters.
- Developed a "Time series analyses and projection" forecasting tool within excel to order stock into the warehouse and out to stores. This maintained an availability per week of 98% while considering yield loss and usage of ingredients.
- Created a forecasting tool that handled long lead times with extremely short shelf life on the products. The tool reacted to changes in day stock cover, waste and forecast trends.
- Maintained an average of 3.4% waste while driving a 15% sales growth for nearly one year within butchery.
- Analysed forecasts and adjusted based on seasonal shifts, public holidays, and in line with upcoming events to minimise Out of Stock situations that may occur.
